Bidding Process

The Downtown Improvement Project Pre-Bid Meeting was well attended with contractors ready to engage and learn more about the project for Phase 1. Complete with a walk down Main Street, contractors, members of the City and a team from Horrocks Engineers, worked collaboratively to dig deep on resolving issues and asking further questions.

The bidding process closed on March 28th at 2 PM. No bids were received, but further action will take place in the coming weeks. The next steps in securing a contract will be to discuss Phase 1 with contractors, both local and out-of-town. Navigating the bidding process in this manner allows the City to ensure this complex project will be completed expeditiously and with careful consideration of businesses impacted.

The Downtown Improvement Project is well on its way to becoming a reality, and we want to thank you all for the many ways you've participated and followed along with the progress of this plan. It is time to unveil the latest and greatest renderings, depicting the possibilities of this project.
