### **Downtown Service Disruptions**

City crews have been working diligently on moving the water mains to help the project's upgraded storm water management system. We are fortunate to have such a supportive community as we work on these upgrades. Our businesses downtown have been incredible to work with. They have consistently given us feedback during the process that has helped us remain agile and adapt accordingly. The community has remained aware of traffic control patterns and construction crews which helps a great deal with safety concerns, both vehicular and pedestrian. We also have dedicated crews working the project, locally and otherwise. So a huge THANK YOU to our community!

We would like to update the citizens on the next few service disruption to our downtown businesses. As we receive feedback from our local businesses operating in downtown, its critical for us to ensure they're being heard and that we accommodate them as much as possible. Because of this, our City crews have remained flexible to ensure we can best meet the needs of our impacted businesses. **Thursday, September 19<sup>th</sup>**, City crews will be arriving on site at 5:00 am and breaking the line at 5:30 am. They will be working swiftly and anticipate having water services back on by 10:00 am. During this time, they will place a valve on the main so that the first block of businesses, East Jackson to E 2<sup>nd</sup> N, are not impacted as they continue their work up Main Street.

**Monday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>**, our City crews will be out there at 8:00 am and will break the line at approximately 1:00 pm. This will affect the second block of Main Street between E 2<sup>nd</sup> N and American Legion. It is anticipated that water will remain shut off for 2-3 hours.
