Downtown Revitalization Updates

Work on East and West Jackson to relocate water mains and install updated storm water management infrastructure is complete. The road is officially opened for through traffic as of Thursday, September 26th. Relocation of the water mains at the Main Street and East 2nd North Street intersection has been completed but will remain closed as crews finalize necessary work. This intersection is anticipated to remain closed for approximately one more week.



New Traffic Patterns

Beginning on Monday, September 30th through access on American Legion from both Main Street and North 2nd East Street will be closed for approximately 2 weeks. Crews are firm on closure times for this main thoroughfare, however, is dependent on weather and underground utilities.

During the first week, September 30th until October 4th, the City's Water Department will be relocating the water main in three areas. After their work is completed, crews will be tackling the storm drain updates from October 7th to October 11th. Once work is completed along American Legion, it will be reopened for through traffic. During this closure, please use detours. East 4th North Street will remain opened for through access and will be part of the detour route.

**Please be advised that a stop sign along Main Street will still be in effect*



Sidewalk Demolition

Sidewalks on Main Street from East Jackson to East 2nd North Street will begin the demolition process on Monday, September 30th. This active sidewalk demo will start along the building face and extend outward 6 feet. In it's place, Guho will be laying a compacted gravel sidewalk and ramps to businesses to meet ADA compliance.

Temporary pedestrian paths and Guho's work paths will be separated by orange fencing for safety reasons. We strongly encourage all citizens in the downtown area to use extreme caution and pay special attention to marked signs and barriers during construction.

From the time the temporary pedestrian paths and business access are implemented, Guho will be working on installing utilities such as electrical trenching, light poles and irrigation to planters. They will be working on this portion of the project until approximately the week of October 14th at which time they will begin the grading for curb and gutter.

As a last major step, curb, gutter and sidewalk will be poured. Guho will continue working with businesses as they pour sidewalk in sections to complete the walkway. They anticipate work on the first block to wrap up by October 25th*.
