Sidewalk Placement

Taking advantage of this perfect fall weather, additional concrete crews came in to get started on sidewalk placement for the first two blocks. They've accomplished quite a bit this week and nearly all of the concrete is poured to the building faces on those two blocks, allowing permanent access to those businesses. *What a huge win!!*

Scheduled to take place the week of November 11th, will be asphalt patching for the first two blocks and the remaining concrete placement from poured pedestrian area, out to the existing curb. Over the next few days and even weeks, crews will be pushing hard to get sidewalks in before winter really sets in. Stay tuned for next week's update with more news regarding the last two blocks of Phase I - Main Street.
