QUALIFICATIONS:

- Graduation from high school or possession of a GED; and
- Experience performing manual and skilled tasks, preferably in the operation and maintenance of equipment used for water pumping, storage, and distribution; or
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to perform the work.

General Statement of Duties: Main duties involve the manual and semi-skilled service work and maintenance of the City's water distribution system including: repairing leaks, installing water taps, replacing cracked and broken pipes, and reading water meters.

Required Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

Knowledge of:

- Operation of large trucks and equipment
- Construction equipment, materials, and methods of water distribution
- Traffic hazards and traffic safety principles, practices, and procedures
- Proper lifting techniques and personal protective equipment used in the operation of hand and power tools

Ability to:

- Comprehend and follow safety rules and regulations
- Operate hand and power tools used in public works facility maintenance and repair
- Communicate well with others, both orally and in writing, using both technical and non-technical language;
- Understand and follow oral and/or written policies, procedures and instructions;
- Operate light and medium-duty equipment and hand/power tools;
- Understand and follow effective safety practices and procedures.

All candidates are required to pass the following to be considered for the above position:

- Ability to pass a background check, driving record, and pre-employment drug/alcohol test
- Possession of a driver's license issued by the State of Idaho
- Obtain a Class A CDL with Tanker endorsement issued by the State of Idaho within 6 months of employment
- Obtain Flagger Certification within one (1) year of employment
- Obtain an Idaho Class I Water Distribution License within one year of eligibility
