QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a US citizen;
- Must have a high school diploma or GED, college education preferred;
- No felony convictions;
- No marijuana use within the past two years and no hard drug use in the past five years;
- Must have a state issued driver's license at time of hire

Physical Requirement: Must possess the strength and physical ability necessary to perform the essential functions of the job. You must be able to pass an Idaho Peace Officers Standards and Training physical fitness test.

Vision and Hearing: You must meet the minimum vision and hearing requirements as defined by the Idaho Peace Officer Standards and Training.

Other Requirements:

All candidates are required to pass the following to be considered for appointment:

- Physical fitness test
- Written exam
- Interview with a board of officers
- Background investigation
- Polygraph exam
- Psychological evaluation
- Interview with the Chief of Police
- If hired, you must live within a fifteen mile radius of the police department
- With a conditional offer of employment, you must also pass a medical exam and pass a drug test
