Joint meeting with the Westside Sewer District for a discussion/decision on the Westside agreement with the City of Mountain Home for Westside sewage disposal and the proposed addendum. ACTION ITEM.

There was a joint meeting with the Mountain Home City Council and the Westside Sewer District present, along with City Attorney, Paul Fitzer and the attorney for The Westside Sewer District, Charles Honsinger to discuss the agreement between the City of Mountain Home and Westside Sewer District for Westside sewage disposal and a proposed addendum to the agreement.

After discussion, City Attorney, Paul Fitzer asked Rich Urquidi, Public Works Director to have James Bledsoe of Keller Associates come back to the Council and the Westside Sewer District with current rates for the cost of sewage disposal and treatment for the City of Mountain Home, so the current rates could be used to calculate the correct percentage that Westside Sewer would be responsible for and the correct amount could go in to the addendum for the agreement between the City and Westside. With the new rates calculated into the proposed addendum, it will be brought back to the City Council and the Westside Sewer District for approval.
