
Q3 Does anyone in your household regularly use a mobility device (e.g., walker, cane, mobility aid, wheelchair)?


Q4 How long have you lived in Mountain Home?


Q5 Since you have lived here, the transportation infrastructure in Mountain Home has:

Q6 For my daily transportation needs, I primarily... (choose one)



Q7 What are the main issues or challenges when driving in Mountain Home? (select up to 3)




Q8 What could the City do to improve driving in Mountain Home?


Q9 Have you ever used Treasure Valley Transit?


Q10 If you have used Treasure Valley Transit, how often do you use it?







Q11 Are you in favor of Mountain Home expanding the bus system?





Q12 What would make it easier for you to use public transportation? (select all that apply)







Q15 Of the issues in the previous question, what are your top three concerns?






Q16 What could the City do to encourage you to walk/bike more?


Q17 If you have children under the age of 17 or and elderly dependent, do you feel comfortable with them walking in the City limits?

Q18 If you have a child under 17, how do they get to and from school?




Q19 If you have a child under 17, how would you prefer they get to school?







Q20 How important is it for the city to look at ways to expand car share and bike share programs?





Q21 How important is it for the City to expand shuttle services between Mountain Home and the Air Force Base?





Q22 Roadway paving conditions on City roads throughout Mountain Home are generally in:





Q23 Sidewalk paving conditions on City roadways throughout Mountain Home are generally in:






Q25 Do you support Amtrak passenger rail service from Salt Lake City to Boise, with a designated stop in Mountain Home?







Q28 Including yourself, how many people live in your household?





Q29 Which of the following age groups do you belong to?






Q31 How many licensed drivers are in your household?
