Starting the construction is a concern and how long into the holiday season it may go. Would like to hear from GUHO to see if they can get this done by the end of construction season or not. Anticipating it may have to stop and be picked up again in March. Councilman Harjo would like to advocate for the URA and bring this to the council, Mayor, and GUHO. \$155,000 has already been spent towards this project and the URA would like to get it going.
